Project Summary and Justification

Project 1 12th Street Revitalization Area

This project combines four phase/sub projects into a single project. The sub project remaining is Phase I - 11th /13th Street Core Area Design and Construction of Public Improvements.

Project 2 O Street Streetscape Redevelopment

Redevelopment of the "O" Street streetscape from 9th Street to 16th Streets - six blocks (9th Street to Centennial Mall) have been budgeted previously. This project will complete the final block (Centennial Mall to 16th Street)

Project 3 Multi-screen Theater Development

The private/public partnership project involves the development of a multi-screen theater and entertainment center in downtown Lincoln. City involvement could include assembly of the site and construction of public improvements.

Project 4 Focus Area Revitalization Activities

The Consolidated Plan for HUD Entitlement Programs includes revitalization activities in identified Focus Areas within designated low to moderate income neighborhoods. Capital improvements may include sidewalk construction, alley construction, park development, and streetscape.

Project 5 Special Assessment Assistance Program

The city undertakes 40 paving districts/units per year. Of the 40 paving districts, three to four may ultimately receive CDBG assistance.

CDBG funds are used for public improvements when the assistance is restricted to paying special assessments levied against properties owned and occupied by persons of low and moderate income to recover the capital costs of the public improvement. Due to CDBG Program budget constraints, City funding assistance is limited to very low income, owner-occupied households.

Project 6 Havelock Revitalization Activities

Havelock revitalization involves streetscape and other public improvements in the Havelock redevelopment area

Project 7 University Place Revitalization

This project involves streetscape and other public improvements in the University Place Redevelopment Area.

Project 8 Northeast Radial Reuse Area Redevelopment

Implementation of the identified North 27th Street Activities: acquisition, relocation, demolition and site improvements; storm and waste water repair and replacement; streetscape implementation; sidewalk, alley and street reconstruction; and construction of public facilities in the area generally located from "N" Street to the overpass at Leighton Avenue.

Project 9 Vine Street Revitalization

Implementation of the Vine Street Design Plan, from 19th Street (to tie into/coordinate with the proposed new Antelope Valley north/south roadway) to 26th Street. Improvements are to include streetscape - sidewalks increased to 8 feet with new concrete walks, ornamental lighting, retaining walls and landscaping; widening Vine Street so sidewalks can be widened and planted medians can be constructed.

Project Summary and Justification (cont.)

Project 10 Antelope Valley Revitalization

Antelope Valley revitalization involves community revitalization activities in and around the Antelope Valley Major Investment Study area. Projects will include Streetscape on "O" Street, from the proposed creek at 16th Street to 21st Street; Streetscape along the proposed new north/south roadway; redevelopment activities along and adjacent to the proposed north/south roadway and creek with most intensive efforts focused north of "O" Street between the road and creek. Redevelopment activities may include acquisition, relocation, demolition and site improvements; repair/replacement of public utilities, sidewalk and alley reconstruction, and construction of public facilities in the area. Housing relocation may also occur which will include site preparation work, ROW acquisition and relocation.

Project 11 Redevelopment Activities


Assistance to projects which focus on the revitalization of older commercial centers by leveraging private sector investment. To be considered for funding under this program, a project must: have the support of a business or neighborhood association, have a measurable economic gain, enhance or compliment other Urban Development Improvement projects or activities, and demonstrate a clear benefit to LMI areas or address the elimination of slums and blight.


Project 12 Entryway Corridors (Phase II)

This projects entails the initial implementation of the Entryway Corridors Study. At the time that this CIP report is being prepared, the Study remains in process, with specific recommendations yet to be finalized and adopted.
