The 2002-2008 Storm Drainage Capital Improvement Program is a combination of projects which require funding on an annual basis and projects requiring one-time funding for construction at specific locations.

- Project 1 City Subsidy to Storm Drainage Construction in Paving Districts
 Project 2 City Subsidy to Storm Drainage Construction in New Subdivisions
- Project 3 Preliminary Storm Drainage Study, Engineering, Emergency Construction and Right-of-Way and Easement Acquisition

Projects 1, 2 and 3 reflect the continuing need to finance the construction of storm drain extensions required in conjunction with the construction of paving districts throughout the City; continuing the policy of not subsidizing storm drain system construction within new subdivisions and the need to provide funding for preliminary engineering, right-of-way and easement acquisition.

Project 4 Miscellaneous Minor Public Storm Drain Improvement, Such as Repairs to Physically Distressed Systems and Upgrading Small Aging Systems

Project 4 is for construction of minor storm drain improvements at various locations in the public storm drain system where deficiencies are causing local drainage problems or repairs are needed to existing facilities. Specific locations have not been identified.

Project 5 Comprehensive Master Storm Water Basin Management Plans

Project 5 provides continuing funding for "Comprehensive Stormwater Drainage Basin Management Plans" including FEMA map updates. These plans will be a tool to manage drainage quantity and quality and prioritize future stormwater expenditures in each drainage basin with the City. LPSNRD will assist in providing funds for this project.

Project 6 Emergency Streambank Protection along Salt Creek and on Beal Slough

Project 6 is for emergency streambank protection along Salt Creek due to bank erosion which is currently threatening the landfill at the area to be protected. Also emergency streambank protection is needed on Beal Slough where a sanitary siphon is being undermined. USACE, LPSNRD, Landfill, and Wastewater are providing the majority of the funds for this project.

Project 7 Channel Improvement and Implementation of Master Planned Basin Projects

Project 7 is the specific channel improvement projects in Master Planned Basins such as Beal Slough, which includes streambed and bank stability measures. LPSNRD will assist in providing funds for these projects.

Project 8 Dead Man's Run Channel Stabilization

Project 8 is for specific channel rehabilitation on Dead Man's Run at the University of Nebraska, Lincoln East Campus. Channel rehabilitation will include channel bank stabilization and grade controls. Funding is anticipated to be cost shared with LPSNRD.

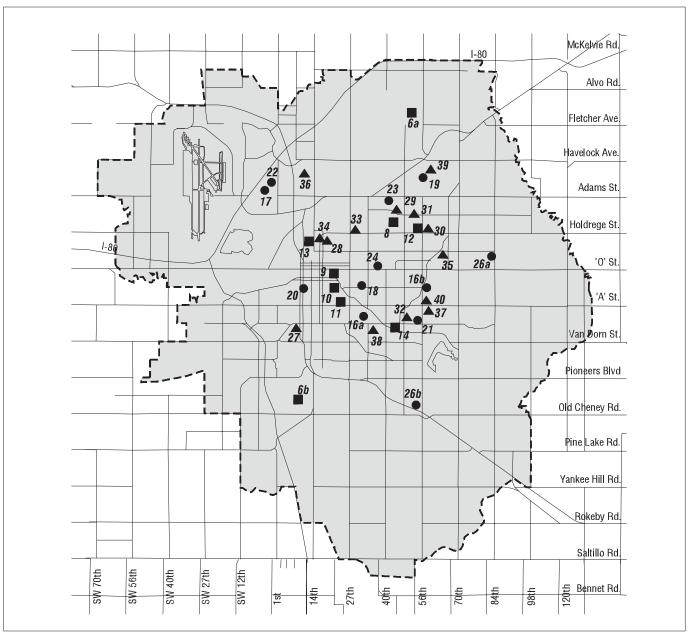
Projects 9 - 44 Various Construction Projects

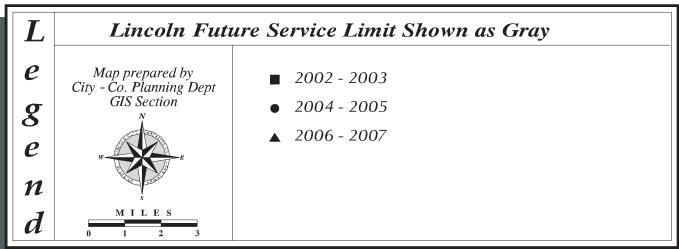
Projects 9 through 44 are construction projects at various locations in the City where no system exists or to replace a structurally deficient system. These projects also include replacement of the existing storm drain systems that do not meet current standards. The lack of a proper storm drain system causes street and private property flooding during intense storm events. These projects were among the projects originally identified and prioritized in a 1979 study or areas identified and studied since the 1979 study. Some of the higher priority projects include storm drainage replacement in conjunction with the Antelope Valley Project. These projects are proposed to be funded by general obligation bonds which must be approved by voters of the City of Lincoln.
