Dear Mr. Owen:

This is to notify the State of revisions to the Lincoln *FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program* (TIP) as defined in the attachment. These revisions affect six (6) State of Nebraska highway projects and one (1) City of Lincoln trail project. State amendments convert five projects from Advance Construction to Federal-aid Projects and program these for FY 2010, and one project is to revise the funding estimate programmed for FY 2010. City of Lincoln revision adds funding to one existing trails project programmed for FY 2010.

These projects are consistent with the *Lincoln-Lancaster Metropolitan Transportation Plan*, are fiscally constrained and have been recommended by the Lincoln MPO Officials Committee in accordance with the MPO Management Plan and Federal regulations. I am endorsing this action by adding these projects to the *FY 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program* for the Lincoln MPO and requesting State concurrence.
