In accordance with the Lincoln Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) "Guidelines for Modifying the Transportation Improvement Program", minor revisions can be made by the Lincoln MPO staff to a project already included in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Administrative revisions are subject to approval by the Planning Director and do not require committee review or approval.

To process administrative modifications, MPO staff will:

- Enter the requested modifications into the project database and map as necessary.
- Prepare and publish an updated TIP project listing.
- Notify the Nebraska Department of Transportation and request that modifications be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- A summary of administrative modification activity report will be prepared for the MPO Technical and Officials Committees and posted on the MPO web page.

Summary Report

The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) is requesting to move programmed funds from FY 2018-19 to Prior Fiscal Years for the below NDOT projects. The project funding has not changed for both projects, and the TIP remains fiscally constrained. This revision will affect the FY 2019-2022 TIP.

Project: Princeton - South of Warlick Blvd.

CN 13237 NH-77-2 (162)

Location: US-77 from approximately 0.4 mi south of Princeton to just north of the Lincoln city limits

Description: Concrete repair, mill/resurface roadway segments, bridge repair, crack & joint seal, fog seal

Project: Ceresco South

CN 13286 NH-77-2 (164)

Location: US-77 from approximately 0.9 mi north Davey Spur (S55E) to approximately 0.6 mi north of Ceresco

Description: Concrete repair, diamond grinding, joint/crack sealing, retrofit granular subdrains
