In accordance with the Lincoln Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) "Guidelines for Modifying the Transportation Improvement Program", minor revisions can be made by the Lincoln MPO staff to a project already included in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Administrative revisions are subject to approval by the Planning Director and do not require committee review or approval.

To process administrative modifications, MPO staff will:

- Enter the requested modifications into the project database and map as necessary.
- Prepare and publish an updated TIP project listing.
- Notify the Nebraska Department of Transportation and request that modifications be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- A summary of administrative modification activity report will be prepared for the MPO Technical and Officials Committees and posted on the MPO web page.

Summary Report

The City of Lincoln: StarTran has requested a minor change to the scope of the Handi-Van Replacement project. This project will replace the handivans with minivans. The project funding has not changed for both projects, and the TIP remains fiscally constrained. This revision will affect the FY 2019-2022 TIP.

Project: Handi-Van Replacement

Description: Funding in FY2018-19 to replace 2 Handivans in 2018. Current 2010 handivans are hybrid electric and will be 8 years old and past their useful life. New handivans are programmed to use CNG fuel.

Attached is a TIP project page for the above project, and it shows the revisions in red.

The Lincoln MPO is requesting NDOT's concurrence for this administrative modification to its FY 2019-2022 TIP.
