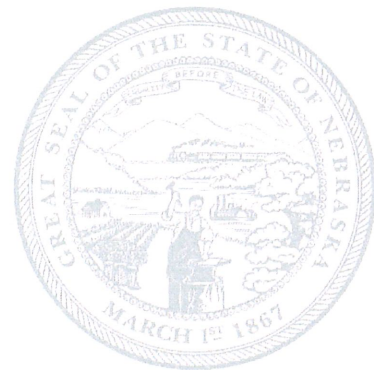

RE: ***Lincoln MPO FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program – Administrative Modification No. 1 Notification***

In accordance with the Lincoln MPO **Guidelines for Modifying the Transportation Improvement Program**, minor revisions can be made by the Lincoln MPO to add grouped projects to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that have a similar function, program type or scope and are consistent with the exempt project classification contained in Federal TIP regulations (23 CFR 450.324 (f)). Administrative revisions are subject to approval by the Planning Director and do not require MPO committee review or approval.

To process administrative modifications, MPO staff will:

- Enter the requested modifications into the project database and map as necessary.
- Prepare and publish an updated TIP project listing.
- Notify the Nebraska Department of Transportation and request that modifications be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- A summary in an administrative modification activity report will be prepared for the MPO Technical and Officials Committees and posted on the MPO web page.

Summary Report

The MPO in coordination with Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) has agreed that NDOT is the appropriate designated recipient to administer in the ***Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program*** – Public Law 112-141, 49 U.S.C 5310 (Section 5310) for the Lincoln urban area.

Description

This program is to provide financial assistance in meeting the transportation needs of elderly persons and persons with disabilities where public transportation services are unavailable, inappropriate or insufficient. The Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility program “is intended to enhance mobility for seniors and persons with disabilities by providing funds for programs to serve the special needs of transit dependent populations beyond traditional public transportation services and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) complementary paratransit services.” Eligible activities include capital and operating projects such as wheelchair-accessible vehicles, taxi vouchers, travel training on how to use fixed-route transit, volunteer driver programs and operations support. NDOT is using Lincoln MPO’s allocation of \$198,560 from FYs 2017-2018 to fund this Program of Projects.

Program of Projects

The Lincoln MPO worked closely with the NDOT, Local Assistance Division - Transit in developing the Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program of Projects for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Applications were reviewed and prioritized to receive the available funds which are recommended for programming.
