

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized under Section 17.22.010 of the
2 Lincoln Municipal code to establish water use charges for all customers of the Lincoln Water
3 System.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
5 Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Effective with the billing cycle commencing on November 15, 2001 and ending
7 on January 15, 2002, the following schedule of water use charges is hereby established and
8 adopted:

9 SCHEDULE A

10 The following rate schedule shall apply to all individually metered residential
11 property. "Residential Property" shall be defined as property consisting of dwelling units. If
12 there is more than one use per master meter on any one property including the residential use, the
13 schedule to be used will be determined as residential, if the residential portion is 50 percent or
14 more of the area of the building.

15 90 cents per 100- cubic for the first 800 cubic feet of water used
16 per dwelling unit each month

17 111 cents per 100 cubic feet for the next 1500 cubic feet of water
18 used per dwelling unit each month

19 155 cents per 100 cubic feet for all additional water used each
20 month

21 The monthly Service Charge shall be hereinafter provided.

SCHEDULE B

The following rate schedule shall apply for the current calendar year to all master metered residential property and all non-residential property that used less than 12,000,000 cubic feet of water in the previous calendar year:

90 cents per 100 cubic fee for the first 8000 cubic feet of water used per month

111 cents per 100 cubic feet for all additional water used each month.

The minimum monthly Service Charge shall be as hereinafter provided

SCHEDULE C

The following rate schedule shall apply for the current year to all non-residential property that used more than 12,000,000 cubic feet of water in the previous calendar year.

75 cents per 100 cubic feet for all water usage

The minimum monthly Service Charge shall be as hereinafter provided

SCHEDULE D

PROVISIONS APPLICABLE
TO ALL TYPES OF WATER SERVICE

Service Charge. There shall be a Service Charge per month to each property using the Lincoln Water System, determined by the number and size of the water meter, or meters, serving such property, to-wit:

13 The Service Charge for a multiple dwelling unit or mobile home shall be at least
14 \$2.00 per dwelling unit or mobile home hookup space per month. In those instances where fire
15 protection considerations dictate that a water meter larger than 1-inch service a single-family
16 dwelling unit located on a single lot, the monthly service charge shall be \$2.00 per dwelling unit.
17 A dwelling unit shall, for the purpose of this schedule, be defined as a room or rooms in which
18 kitchen facilities are provided, located in the building or structure used by a facility or household
19 as a home residence of the family or household.

20 WATER RATES TO CUSTOMERS OUTSIDE
21 THE CITY LIMITS

22 Customers located outside the City Limits of Lincoln and serviced by the water
23 system of the City of Lincoln shall pay the same water rates charged to customers within the City
24 Limits of Lincoln for water furnished them by the water system of the City of Lincoln.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. A-73784 adopted by the City
26 Council on September 24, 1990 is hereby superseded.
