**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide the authority to construct a 6-inch water main in NW 23rd Street, West "Q" to West "O" and assess the cost thereof against the benefitted property.

## **D I S C U S S I O N**

The petitioner is requesting this district to serve property owned by the petitioner. The assessment will include only those properties that have not been served by a previous improvement and assessment under Water District No. 787, with the City of Lincoln subsidizing the remaining cost.

A maximum assessment of \$40.00 per front foot has been proposed. The S.A.R. committee approved funding in September 2002.

NO C.D.B.G. funding allowed since this is utility related.
