

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the City Council of Lincoln, Nebraska, is authorized under Chapter 17.60 of
2 the Lincoln Municipal Code to establish wastewater surcharge unit costs for customers of the
3 Lincoln Wastewater System subject to such a surcharge; and

4 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 17.60.060 and 17.60.070 of the Lincoln
5 Municipal Code, the Director of Public Works and Utilities has determined the unit cost to the City
6 of removing suspended solids, of removing biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) or chemical oxygen
7 demand (COD), and of other additional treatment required for industrial wastes flowing into the
8 City’s wastewater treatment facilities.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,
10 Nebraska:

11 That effective with the billing cycle commencing on January 15, 2005, and ending on
12 February 15, 2005, the following schedule is hereby established and adopted:

13 The surcharge unit costs for each property discharging industrial wastes or other high strength
14 wastewater are hereby found and determined to be as follows:

15 Rp = Unit BOD cost (or COD cost when used in lieu of BOD)
16 Eleven and seven-tenths cents per pound (\$0.117/lb.)

17 Rs = Unit suspended solids cost
18 Fifteen cents per pound (\$0.150/lb.)

19 Rx = Not applicable (\$0.00/lb.)

20 If, in the opinion of the Director, the foregoing surcharge unit cost determination is
21 inequitable to either the City or the users affected because of unusual economic or waste load
22 circumstances, then the Director shall by an appropriate method determine new surcharge unit costs
23 which more accurately reflect the actual economic and waste load impact on the wastewater system

1 pursuant to § 17.60.070 of the Lincoln Municipal Code.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. A-78939, adopted by the City Council
on August 10, 1998, is hereby superseded.
