1 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, adopted Chapter 2.81 of the Lincoln
2 Municipal Code known as the "Lincoln-Living Wage Ordinance" on March 1, 2004; and

3 WHEREAS, the Living Wage Ordinance is intended to legislate minimum wages and
4 health benefits of individuals that perform pursuant to a contract with the City; and

5 WHEREAS, Section 2.81.080 provides for waivers to said ordinance; and

6 WHEREAS, the Capital Humane Society, Contractor through the Lincoln-Lancaster
7 County Health Department, has applied for such a waiver and has provided the necessary
8 documentation; and

9 WHEREAS, the Finance Department has reviewed the Contractor's application to waive
10 the requirements of Chapter 2.81 and has recommended approval of this waiver; and

11 WHEREAS, the Contractor has demonstrated the waiver is in the best interest of the
12 City.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,
14 Nebraska:

15 That pursuant to Section 2.81.080 of the Lincoln Municipal Code, the Capital Humane
16 Society is hereby granted a one-year waiver to the Lincoln Living Wage Ordinance.
