

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 12.04.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
 2 relating to the Park and Recreation Advisory Board Membership to allow greater flexibility in the
 3 requirements for student appointments to serve on the Board; and repealing Section 12.04.010 of the
 4 Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Section 12.04.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read
 7 as follows:

8 **12.04.010 Created; Membership.**

9 (a) There is hereby created a Park and Recreation Advisory Board which shall consist
 10 of sixteen voting members appointed from the following categories:

- 11 (1) Ten persons who are residents of the City of Lincoln;
- 12 (2) Two persons who need not be residents of the City of Lincoln but must be
 13 residents of Lancaster County;
- 14 (3) Two persons who are residents of Lincoln or Lancaster County, and who are
 15 currently attending high school or college in the City of Lincoln ~~who~~ and have completed their
 16 ~~sophomore~~ freshman year of high school;
- 17 (4) One member of the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners; and
- 18 (5) One member of the City Council.

19 One member, other than the elected officials and the ~~high school~~ students, shall be
 20 a representative of the school district of the City of Lincoln.

1 (b) The Mayor shall make all appointments to the Board with the approval of the City
2 Council except for the City Council member who shall be appointed by the City Council.

3 (c) All appointments to the Board shall be for staggered terms of three years, except for
4 appointments of the County Board member, the City Council member, and the two ~~high school~~
5 students, which shall be for terms of one year. The ~~high school~~ students shall be appointed in June
6 of each year to serve during ~~their junior year of high school~~ the following year. Appointments to
7 fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired term and shall be made in the same manner as original
8 appointments.

9 (d) Any member of the Board may be removed by action of the Mayor and City Council
10 for malfeasance or nonfeasance of duty.

11 (e) All members of the Board shall serve without pay.

12 (f) Seven members of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

13 Section 2. That Section 12.04.010 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing
14 be and the same is hereby repealed.

15 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
16 passage and publication according to law.
