## **F A C T S H E E T**

**TITLE:** Repeal Ordinance No. 18374 creating Paving District No. 2628, North 36<sup>th</sup> Street “W” to Vine Street.

**SPONSOR:** City of Lincoln Public Works

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Neutral

**APPLICANT:** City of Lincoln Public Works

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide the authority to repeal Ordinance No. 18374 creating Paving District No. 2628, North 36<sup>th</sup> Street, “W” to Vine Street, based on lack of majority of frontage needed to bring district before City Council and order constructed under resolution.

## **D I S C U S S I O N**

The City Council created Paving District No. 2628 on June 7, 2004. The necessary majority of frontage needed for the district to be ordered constructed under resolution form has not been obtained through the formal petition process. The City Council has set in policy that a paving district that did not have the majority of frontage necessary to advance into resolution stage, be repealed when the one year time frame for securing the necessary majority had matured.

The total frontage for the district is calculated at 568 feet. A total of 142 frontage feet has been submitted in formal petition.
