

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 6.10 of the Lincoln Municipal Code relating  
2 to Dangerous and Potentially Dangerous Dogs by amending Section 6.10.050 to increase the  
3 registration fee of potentially dangerous dogs from \$5.00 to \$25.00; and repealing Section 6.10.050  
4 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Section 6.10.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read  
7 as follows:

8 **6.10.050 Registration Requirements; Potentially Dangerous Dogs.**

9 (a) The owner of any potentially dangerous dog shall register such dog with Animal  
10 Control and upon registration shall provide the following:

11 (1) The name, address and telephone number of the owner;

12 (2) A written acknowledgment that the owner shall notify Animal Control  
13 immediately or when the owner has any knowledge or belief that the dog has bitten or is alleged to  
14 have bitten a human being or another animal;

15 (3) A written acknowledgment that the owner of said dog shall notify Animal  
16 Control of any changes in material recorded as a part of the registration within twenty-four hours  
17 of said change. Changes in material recorded as part of the registration shall include information  
18 that the dog has been sold, given away, or otherwise transferred to any other person, and in that  
19 event the registered owner shall provide the director with the name, address, and telephone number  
20 of such person; and

21 (4) A non-refundable registration fee of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, which fee  
22 shall be in addition to any other license fee required by this chapter.

23 (b) Upon satisfactory completion of all the requirements of this section the director shall  
24 issue a registration certificate which shall be used to assign the dog a permanent number.

1 (c) The registration requirements including the notification requirements acknowledged  
2 therein shall be construed as affirmative duties upon the owner, failure of which shall constitute a  
3 violation of this section.

4 (d) It shall be unlawful for any person registering a dog to falsify or misrepresent  
5 material recorded as a part of the registration.

6 Section 2. That Section 6.10.050 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing  
7 be and the same is hereby repealed.

8 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
9 passage and publication according to law.
