

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Lincoln desires
2 to accept the State of Nebraska Game and Parks Commission Recreational Trails
3 Program Project Agreement for assistance from the Nebraska Game and Parks
4 Commission for Recreation Trails Program (RTP) for the replacement of approximately
5 .35 mile of asphalt trail with concrete in Tierra Park from Tierra/Williamsburg Trail to
6 Rock Island Trail and 27th Street to Tierra neighborhood; and

7 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln wishes to express its support for the project and
8 its willingness to commit to the cost of maintenance of the completed improvements in a
9 safe and attractive manner for the public.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of
11 Lincoln, Nebraska:

12 1. That the City of Lincoln hereby accepts the State of Nebraska Game and
13 Parks Commission Recreational Trails Program Project Agreement supporting the
14 application being made by its Parks and Recreation Department to the Nebraska Game
15 and Parks Commission for financial assistance from the Recreational Trails Program for
16 the construction of the .35 asphalt trail in Tierra Park from Tierra/Williamsburg Trail to
17 Rock Island Trail and 27th Street to Tierra neighborhood.

18 2. The City of Lincoln has available and will apply its share of the project cost
19 (\$18,100) and has the financial capability to maintain and will maintain the completed
20 improvements in a safe and attractive manner for public use.

1 3. The City of Lincoln will not discriminate against any person on the basis of
2 race, color, age, religion, handicap, sex, or national origin in the use of the proposed
3 project acquired or developed pursuant to the application for financial assistance. The
4 City of Lincoln certifies that it has the financial capabilities to maintain the completed
5 improvements in a safe and attractive manner for public use and further certifies that it
6 will comply, where applicable, with the Americans with Disabilities Act by making the
7 facilities accessible to the handicapped.

8 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary and
9 required to make application to acquire said grant funds.

10 5. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to
11 the Parks and Recreation Department for transmittal to the Nebraska Game and Parks
12 Commission.
