

Mr. Blum:

Per your request, I'm writing to state our intentions regarding a right-of-way permit for our coffee roaster flue in the shop we're leasing at 2723 N. 48th Street. Enclosed is a drawing which illustrates the way the chimney pipe will go through the north wall of the building, then straight up the side to a height above the roof line.

The right-of-way issue has come up since the pipe will extend into the walking alley on the north side of the building. The outer diameter of the chimney is about 10 inches, and it will be bracketed to the wall of the building, so it will only stick out from the wall a maximum of 12-15 inches. There are already two electrical poles against the side of the building that extend at least this far into the alley right-of-way.


Regarding the required bond and insurance, we're already covered with a \$500,000 liability policy, and I've been informed by our insurance agent (McCashland-Kirby) that the \$5,000 bond will be no problem. However, McCashland-Kirby will need information from you about how the bond needs to be written. Once they have that, they said the bond could be issued in 2-3 days. They will also generate a certificate of insurance so you have a hard copy of that.
