REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To accept and approve an agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads for additional Federal Funds for reconstruction of the Harris Overpass along 'O' Street between 3rd and 9th streets, State Project No. BR-5266(1), City Project No. 701781.

DISCUSSION

The City of Lincoln proposes to replace Harris Overpass on 'O' Street between 3rd and 9th streets. This bridge was identified as structurally deficient in year 2001 and is scheduled to begin reconstruction in November 2007.

The City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska entered into an agreement for Federal Bridge Replacement Funds in December 2003. It is now necessary to amend this agreement to authorize use of Federal CMAQ and STP Funds to the Harris Overpass City of Lincoln CIP project 701781.
