**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To amend the existing Interlocal Agreement between the RTSD and the City for the North Lincoln Quiet Zone Project over BNSF railroad by increasing funding by the RTSD.

## DISCUSSION

The Railroad Transportation Safety District (RTSD) and the City of Lincoln entered into agreement executed on March 13, 2007, by the RTSD and April 11, 2007, by the City under Resolution #84324 for safety improvements at the BNSF Railroad crossings at North 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, Adams Street, North 44<sup>th</sup> Street and North 70<sup>th</sup> Street for the purpose of creating a quiet zone withing the city.

The District had previously approved \$259,000 for the quiet zone project, and is increasing that amount by \$108,000, for a total of 367,000 to be applied for the Quiet Zone Project improvements.
