REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To amend the existing Interlocal Agreement between the RTSD and the City for the North Lincoln Quiet Zone Project over BNSF railroad by increasing funding by the RTSD.

D I S C U S S I O N

The Railroad Transportation Safety District (RTSD) and the City of Lincoln entered into agreement executed on March 13, 2007, by the RTSD and April 11, 2007, by the City under Resolution #84324 for safety improvements at the BNSF Railroad crossings at North 33rd Street, Adams Street, North 44th Street and North 70th Street for the purpose of creating a quiet zone within the city.

The District had previously approved \$259,000 for the quiet zone project, and is increasing that amount by \$108,000, for a total of 367,000 to be applied for the Quiet Zone Project improvements.
