

RESOLUTION NO. A- _____

1 WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized, pursuant to Section 8.32.100 of the
2 Lincoln Municipal Code, to establish or revise, by resolution, fees to be charged to any
3 person for the privilege of using any public landfill or other waste disposal facility owned by
4 the City, and;

5 WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to revise the fees for use of the
6 City’s public landfill and other waste disposal facilities as last revised by Resolution No. A-
7 83985 passed by the City Council on August 21, 2006;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
9 Lincoln, Nebraska:

10 That effective September 1, 2013, the following schedules of use charges are hereby
11 established and adopted:

12 SCHEDULE A – Small Vehicle Transfer Station

13 FLAT FEE SCHEDULE

14 The following rates shall be applied to all vehicles having a one-ton rating or less,
15 with a cargo height of 5 feet or less; and trailers with a flatbed carrying size of 60 square
16 feet or less, with a cargo height of 5 feet or less using the Small Vehicle Transfer Station:

17	Cars per vehicle trip	\$3.00
18	Passenger Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$6.00
19	Cargo Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$11.00
20	Trailers per vehicle trip	\$11.00
21	Any above vehicle and trailer per vehicle trip	\$14.00

22 Any uncovered load will be assessed an additional amount equal to 50% of the
23 charge for such load.

1 SCHEDULE B – Municipal Solid Waste Landfill

2 COMPUTED (WEIGHED) RATE SCHEDULE

3 The following rate shall be applied to all vehicles greater than one-ton rating, trailers
4 with a flatbed carrying size of greater than 60 square feet, and all vehicles and trailers
5 regardless of weight or size with a cargo height of greater than 5 feet using the Municipal
6 Solid Waste Landfill on a load weight basis as follows:

7 \$16.00 Per Ton

8 The minimum charge shall be equal to the per ton rate of \$16.00. For periods that
9 the scale is inoperative, the rate charged shall be \$5.20 per cubic yard. Any uncovered load
10 will be assessed an additional amount equal to 50% of the computed charge for such load.
11 The minimum fee for uncovered loads shall be \$50.00.

12 SCHEDULE C – Compost Facility

13 FLAT FEE SCHEDULE

14 The following rates shall be applied to all vehicles having a one-ton rating or less,
15 with a cargo height of 5 feet or less; and trailers with a flatbed carrying size of 60 square
16 feet or less, with a cargo height of 5 feet or less using the Compost Facility:

17	Cars per vehicle trip	\$3.00
18	Passenger Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$6.00
19	Cargo Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$11.00
20	Trailers per vehicle trip	\$11.00
21	Any above vehicle and trailer per vehicle trip	\$14.00

22 Any uncovered load will be assessed an additional amount equal to 50% of the
23 charge for such load.

1 COMPUTED (WEIGHED) RATE SCHEDULE

2 The following rate shall be applied to all vehicles greater than a one-ton rating,
3 trailers with a flatbed carrying size of greater than 60 square feet and all vehicles and trailers
4 regardless of weight or size with a cargo height of greater than 5 feet using the Compost
5 Facility on a load weight basis as follows:

6 \$15.75 Per Ton

7 The minimum charge shall be equal to the per ton rate of \$15.75. For periods that
8 the scale is inoperative, the rate charged shall be \$8.00 per cubic yard. Any uncovered load
9 will be assessed an additional amount equal to 50% of the computed charge for such load.
10 The minimum fee for uncovered loads shall be \$50.00.

11 SCHEDULE D – Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill

12 FLAT RATE SCHEDULE

13 The following rates shall be applied to all vehicles having a one-ton rating or less,
14 with a cargo height of 5 feet or less; and trailers with a flatbed carrying size of 60 square
15 feet or less, with a cargo height of 5 feet or less using the Construction and Demolition
16 Debris Landfill:

17	Cars per vehicle trip	\$4.00
18	Passenger Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$4.00
19	Cargo Vehicles per vehicle trip	\$4.00
20	Trailers per vehicle trip	\$4.00
21	Any above vehicle and trailer per vehicle trip	\$4.00

22 COMPUTED (WEIGHED) RATE SCHEDULE

23 The following rate shall be applied to all vehicles greater than a one-ton rating, trailers with
24 a flatbed carrying size of greater than 60 square feet, all vehicles and trailers regardless of
25 weight or size with a cargo height of greater than 5 feet using the Construction and

1 Demolition Debris Landfill on a load weight basis:

2 \$4.00 Per Ton

3 The minimum charge shall be equal to the per ton rate of \$4.00. For periods that the
4 scale is inoperative, the rate charged shall be \$4.00 per cubic yard.

5 SCHEDULE E – Special Wastes

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7 1. Special Wastes as defined by Municipal Code 8.32.080

8 1a. Special Wastes landfilled directly with other refuse at time
9 of disposal Schedule B per ton rate plus
10 \$5.00 per permit administrative fee

11 Minimum Charge (1 ton rate plus \$5.00) \$21.00

12 1b. Special Wastes requiring segregation from other refuse
13 at time of disposal (including, but not limited to,
14 asbestos containing materials) Schedule B per ton rate plus
15 \$25.00 per load special handling fee

16 Minimum Charge (1 ton rate plus \$25.00) \$41.00

17 1c. Cars, Passenger Vehicles, Cargo Vehicles and Trailers as defined in
18 Schedule A with Special Wastes Applicable Schedule A fee plus
19 \$5.00 per permit administrative fee

20 SCHEDULE F - Special Fees

21 1. All whole and processed tires (portions of tires)

22 1a. Car passenger tire or light truck tire \$3.00 each
23 plus applicable Schedule A or Schedule B fees

24 1b. Heavy (over-the-road) truck tire \$6.50 each
25 plus applicable Schedule A or Schedule B fees

26 1c. Farm or industrial (off-road) tire \$11.50 each
27 plus applicable Schedule A or Schedule B fees

28 2. All appliances prohibited from land disposal \$5.00 each
29 plus applicable Schedule A or Schedule B fees

1 3. The following fee shall be assessed for wastes which are unacceptable, including but
2 not limited to out-of-county wastes, or prohibited from land disposal, if they are
3 found to exist in a load and the vehicle driver fails to remove the waste or place the
4 waste in the designated areas.

5 Unacceptable waste loads rejected \$50.00 per occurrence

6 The Director of Public Works & Utilities shall have the authority to negotiate for and
7 collect fees on any wastes that may require unusual or special handling considerations other
8 than those wastes addressed herein. The Director of Public Works & Utilities shall have the
9 authority to issue rules and regulations which further define vehicle types, uncovered loads,
10 unacceptable wastes and other policies for the City's solid waste disposal facilities and
11 operations.

12 The Mayor shall have the authority to waive all or any portion of the scheduled fees
13 in the event of an emergency or natural disaster which creates the need for immediate
14 disposal of wastes resulting from such emergency.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. A-83985, adopted by the City
16 Council on August 21, 2006, is hereby superseded.
