CONSENT A M E N D M E N T S

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 8.08 of the Lincoln Municipal Code relating to Body
 2 Art Establishments, Chapter 8.14 relating to Child Care Programs, and Chapter 8.20 relating to the
 3 Lincoln Food Code, by amending Section 8.08.060 to provide that any initial body art establishment
 4 permit issued on or after May 15 and before July 1 shall be valid until June 30 of the following year;
 5 amending Section 8.14.037 to provide that any new certificate of compliance for a child care
 6 program issued on or after December 15 and before February 1 shall be valid until January 31 of the
 7 following year; amending Section 8.20.150 to provide that any new food establishment permit, other
 8 than a temporary food establishment permit, issued on or after April 15 and before June 1 shall be
 9 valid until May 31 of the following year; and repealing Sections 8.08.060, 8.14.037, and 8.20.150
 10 of the Lincoln Municipal as hitherto existing.

11 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

12 Section 1. That Section 8.08.060 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read
 13 as follows:

14 **8.08.060 Body Art Establishment; Permit Fees.**

15 (a) The fee for a body art establishment permit shall be as follows:

<u>Body Art Establishment</u>	<u>Initial</u>	<u>Renewal</u>
One (1) to five (5) stations	\$390.00	\$260.00
Each additional five (5) stations	\$160.00	\$120.00

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 19 (b) Any initial body art establishment permit issued after ~~the thirtieth of November of~~
 20 each calendar year December 31 and before May 15 shall pay 67% of the initial fee. Any initial
 21 body art establishment permit issued on or after May 15 and before July 1 shall pay the initial fee
 22 and such permit shall be valid until June 30 of the following year. Renewal of all body art

1 establishment permits shall be as required in Section 8.08.080. The fees shall be payable to the
2 Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department and the Health Director shall deposit the fees at the
3 City Treasurer's Office. The City Treasurer shall credit the fees to the Health Fund.

4 Section 2. That Section 8.14.037 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read
5 as follows:

6 **8.14.037 Fees.**

7 (a) The following fees are required:

8 (1) Plan review for new, remodeled or relocated child care programs \$115.00

9 (2) Fee for certificate of compliance (initial or renewal)
10 School-age child care program \$115.00

11 All other child care programs:

12 Providing care for less than four hours per day \$115.00

13 Providing care for four or more hours per day with:

14 50 or less children \$145.00

15 51 to 100 children \$170.00

16 101 or more children \$200.00

17 (The number of children shall be based
18 on licensing capacity, if applicable.)

19 (b) Any person issued a new certificate of compliance after July 31 and before December
20 15 of each year shall pay 67% of the annual fee. Any person issued a new certificate of compliance
21 on or after December 15 and before February 1 shall pay the initial fee and such permit shall be valid
22 until January 31 of the following year.

23 (c) Fees shall be payable to the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department and the Health
24 Director shall deposit the fees at the City Treasurer's Office. The City Treasurer shall credit the fees
25 to the Health Fund. No fees shall be refunded.

26 Section 3. That Section 8.20.150 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read as
27 follows:

28 **8.20.150 Food Establishment; Permit Fees**

29 (a) Any person who secures a food establishment permit under the Lincoln Food Code shall
30 pay the appropriate fee as follows:

1	(1) Food Establishment:	
2	Food establishment -- new permit	\$495.00
3	Food establishment -- renewal	\$340.00
4	Each additional food preparation facility	
5	(new or renewal)	\$155.00
6	(2) Mobile Food Unit:	
7	New or renewal as additional facility	\$155.00
8	(3) Food Catering Services:	
9	Operating as an additional food preparation facility to	
10	an approved food establishment:	
11	New or renewal	\$155.00
12	(4) Temporary Food Establishment:	
13	(a) Operating for a single event not to exceed	
14	fourteen consecutive days	
15	Temporary food establishment	\$140.00
16	With a related food establishment	\$ 70.00
17	Nonprofit organization	\$ 70.00
18	(b) Operating annually for more than one single event not to exceed	
19	fourteen consecutive days	
20	Temporary food establishment	\$420.00
21	Non-Profit Organization	\$210.00
22	(c) Operating as an additional food preparation facility to an approved	
23	food establishment	
24	New or renewal	\$155.00
25		
26	(d) Event Market:	
27	One to five vendors	\$155.00
28	Each additional five vendors	\$155.00
29	(e) Farmers' Market:	
30	Basic Fee	\$ 85.00
31	Plus: Vendor fee for each vendor selling foods	
32	other than fruits, vegetables and products	
33	permitted by the Nebraska Department of	
34	Agriculture	\$ 20.00

35 (b) Any person issued a new food establishment permit, other than a temporary food
36 establishment permit, after November 30 and before April 15 of each year shall pay 67% of the

1 ~~annual~~ new permit fee. Any person issued a new food establishment permit, other than a temporary
2 food establishment permit, on or after April 15 and before June 1 shall pay the new permit fee and
3 such permit shall be valid until May 31 of the following year.

4 (c) Fees shall be payable to the Health Director and the Health Director shall deposit the fees
5 at the City Treasurer’s Office. The City Treasurer shall credit the fees to the Health Fund.

6 Section 4. That Sections 8.08.060, 8.14.037, and 8.20.150 of the Lincoln Municipal
7 Code as hitherto existing be and the same are hereby repealed.

8 Section 5. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall be
9 posted on the official bulletin board of the City, located on the wall across from the City Clerk's
10 office at 555 S. 10th Street, in lieu of and in place of newspaper publication with notice of passage
11 and such posting to be given by publication one time in the official newspaper by the City Clerk.
12 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as herein
13 and in the City Charter provided.
