## REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Multi-year agreement - 4 years.

### DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department (LLCHD) has been the lead agency for Safe Kids Lincoln-Lancaster County since it was chartered in 1995. With recent restructuring and rebranding of Safe Kids Worldwide, coalitions are being asked to operate under a new agreement. LLCHD works with community partners on program goals of reducing unintentional injury to children ages 0-14 through six Task Forces (Child Passenger Safety, Fire & Burn Prevention, Water Safety, Sports Injury Prevention, Pedestrian & Bike Safety, and Home Safety). The Lincoln Police Department, Lincoln Fire & Rescue, and Public Works & Utilities staff partner on these program goals and participate on Task Forces.

No new staffing is required for this agreement. Existing staff provide in-kind support.
