REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Approving an Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District to transfer the use of two wells, associated monitoring wells and a reservoir located in the former Antelope Valley wellfield to Lower Platte South Natural Resources District to be used for low flow augmentation of Antelope Creek for a term of one hundred years.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Lower Platte South NRD has indicated an interest in utilizing some of the Lincoln Water System's wellfield facilities that are no longer used by LWS. The NRD intends to use the facilities to augment the flows at certain times in Antelope Creek and for other purposes, as they deem appropriate. This involves the transfer of two production wells, nine monitoring wells and an unused reservoir that the City no longer has in service, all located in the general vicinity of 29th and Garfield Streets. This license agreement is for a term of 100 years, at a cost of \$40,000. All costs associated with maintenance and operation of the wells and reservoir shall be borne by the NRD.
