REASON FOR LEGISLATION

Lincoln Parks & Recreation will be applying to the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission (NGPC) for federal assistance from the Land & Water Conservation Grant to provide funding support to the renovation of Lakeview Park. In support of this grant application, a resolution approved by City Council is required that states the following:

The Mayor is authorized to sign documents to obtain financial assistance, including a Project Agreement with the State of Nebraska and the National Park Service.

The City of Lincoln, Nebraska has budgeted its 50 percent match to the proposed total project funds and will allocate these funds toward this project upon project approval by NGPC.

The City has the financial capability to operate and maintain the completed project and park property in a safe, attractive and sanitary manner.

The City will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, age, religion, disability, sex or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to the project proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-354 (1964), and any of the regulations promulgated pursuant to such Act by the Secretary of the Interior and contained in 43 CFR 17.

No property acquired and/or developed under the this project shall, without the approval of NGPC and the Secretary of the Interior, be converted to other than public outdoor recreation use. And, such approval may be granted only if it is in accord with the then existing Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP), and only upon such conditions as deemed necessary to assure the substitution of other outdoor recreation properties of at least equal fair market value and of reasonable equivalent usefulness and location.

The City will replace the land in the event of a conversion in use in accordance with Section 6(f)(3) of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, as amended.

The City agrees to comply with all State and Federal requirements and standards where they can be applied in making the facilities developed under this project, and all future projects accessible to and usable by the disabled.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

This project will involve the renovation of the existing playground and other park amenities at Lakeview Park. Other amenities may include repairs to an existing picnic shelter, replacement of an existing drinking fountain, additional sidewalks and trees. The source of funds for the City's match (50 percent) is Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds identified for park improvements in low/moderate income areas of the City appropriated through the Urban Development Department's CIP.
