The City of Lincoln and The Schemmer Associates wish to enter into a Supplemental agreement, which will establish responsibilities and fees for additional work related to completion of a noise study, for preliminary engineering and NEPA Phase services for safety improvements at the intersection of N. 14th St. & the Eastbound Off-Ramp to U.S. Highway 6 in the City of Lincoln. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City of Lincoln and State of Nebraska (District 1) each providing a 5% contribution.
