#### REASON FOR LEGISLATION

To provide authority for the Mayor to sign the contract for the 66th St. and Fremont St. Intersection Safety Project, HSIP-5253(1), CN 13227, City Project #702682. This resolution states that the City concurs with awarding the contract to MTZ Construction Inc. The agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads (NDOR) allows the use of Federal Transportation Program Funds for construction and construction engineering of the intersection reconstruction at 66th St. and Fremont St.

#### DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Lincoln (City) receives an annual apportionment of Federal Surface Transportation funds (STP) administered by the Nebraska Department of Roads. The original programming agreement for this project was executed by the City on August 13, 2012 under Resolution A-86959.

Bids were opened February 8, 2018 and the bid information shared at the public hearing on February 12, 2018 did not include the name of the lowest responsible bidder in the Resolution approved by the Council. This resolution amends previous Resolution A-90893 to include this information. The cost split will be 90% federal funds and 10% local funds.
