Call Meeting to Order; Approval of Previous Minutes:

Review Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Budget Statement:

Figard and Jerina provided the Board with a summary of the key provisions of the budget and expenditure report, which was preliminarily approved at the June meeting along with approval of a levy request to the County Board to support such budget in the amount \$0.022217 per one hundred dollars of actual property valuation (which the County Board approved on August 25, 2022 by Resolution No. R-22-0075).

Vest called for public comments regarding the proposed RTSD Budget. No one came forward with any comments or questions.

Schorr moved to adjourn the meeting
Raybould seconded the motion. Motion approved 4-0.
