**Call to Order & Recognition of 'Open Meetings Act':** As per law, Chairman Bennie Shobe announced that the Board follows the regulations of the Open Meetings Act, and called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m. Roll was called by Angela Chesnut, Secretary.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** A motion was made by Barbara Baier and seconded by Richard Meginnis to approve the minutes of the August 29, 2019 SSKI Board meeting as presented. Upon roll call vote members voted as follows: **"Yes": Barbara Baier, Leirion Gaylor Baird, Lanny Boswell, Kathy Danek, Richard Meginnis, Bennie Shobe. "No": None. Motion carried.**

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** No one from the public requested to speak with the Board.

## **REPORT ON SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS/PROGRAM STATUS:**

John Neal, Lincoln Public Schools Assistant Superintendent for Governmental Relations and General Administration, provided an update (copy of PowerPoint presentation and handout attached to official minutes on record) on the School Resource Office program and the impact of LB 390, as well as the timeline for updating the LPS/City Memorandum of Understanding regarding SRO's. LB 390 was passed in the recent legislative session to establish specific requirements for SRO MOU's with public school systems which includes seven new requirements. New LB 390 requirements were reviewed and explained, with Board member questions discussed by John Neal and Captain Ryan Dale of Lincoln Police Department. Data collection is ongoing with the first presentation of this data scheduled for the October 2020 SSKIB meeting, for the 2019-20 school year. Nebraska Department of Education will be developing a model MOU which may then be adapted by LPS and City of Lincoln, and any changes will be shared with the SSKIB at the October 2020 meeting.

Captain Ryan Dale also shared information regarding current and ongoing training of SRO's, which well exceeds the 20-hour requirement. Officers meet training requirements prior to being placed in an SRO position.

Dr. Leslie Eastman of LPS provided data collection resources currently in place and utilized by all students and parents at all schools.

Timeline for implementation of LB 390 new requirements:

- Now to November 30, 2019: NDE develops model SRO MOU
- December 1, 2019: Model MOU made public
- December 2019-February 2020: LPS and City draft amendments to existing MOU to be approved in March 2020 by Board and Council
- March-August 2020: Prepare and implement any required changes in the amendments to the MOU in time for the 2020-2021 school year and in advance of the January 2021 deadline for either adopting the NDE model or assuring that our MOU is substantially similar with it.
- August-October 2020: Prepare any changes to the SRO Evaluation process to align with any changes made to the MOU to share with the SSKI Board.
