Dave Kroeker, Budget and Fiscal Director, explained that Nebraska Revised Statute §23-120 allows the County to acquire, purchase, construct, renovate, remodel, furnish, equip, add to, improve, or provide a suitable courthouse, jail and other county buildings and a site or sites for such. He added that it allows a levy of up to 5.2 cents per \$100 of taxable property value for such projects. Kroeker added that the projects cannot exceed ten years in duration.

MOTION: Steinman moved and Workman seconded approval of Resolution 99-2368. On call Workman, Campbell and Steinman voted aye. Motion carried.
