3 MARSH USA INC. CONTRACT - Georgia Glass, Personnel Director; Bill Kostner, City Risk Manager; Diane Staab, Deputy County Attorney

Bill Kostner, City Risk Manager, reported that Marsh USA Inc. has agreed to hold their consulting fee at last year's figure of \$8,616 for the remainder of the contract period (June 1, 2001 through May 31, 2002). He also reported the findings of his research on how other local employers handle the purchase of health insurance (see agenda packet).

Georgia Glass, Personnel Director, said the City has decided to renew its contract with Marsh USA, Inc. for one more year and said it is her recommendation that the County do so also. The City and County could then proceed with a Request for Proposals (RFP) for an insurance consultant after the first of the year.

The Board concurred with that recommendation.

Diane Staab, Deputy County Attorney, said she will prepare an addendum to the contract with Marsh USA, Inc. for action at a County Board of Commissioners Meeting.

Glass noted that the Personnel Department will be meeting with representatives of Marsh USA, Inc. the week of June 11th to discuss insurance rates.

Hudkins requested additional information on Frank Hack and Associates, insurance consultant for The Gallup Organization.
