An interlocal agreement for the Harvest Project with the Lincoln Area Agency on Aging's Lincoln Information for the Elderly (LAAA/LIFE) for a full-time employee to deliver specialized care manager services to the elderly in Lancaster County who are at risk due to complex mental health, substance abuse and age related needs and to determine suitability to the project. The term of the agreement is July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003. The County shall pay up to \$48,108. (C-02-0453)

8) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

A contract with ARAMARK Correctional Services, Inc. for annual food service requirements for the Lancaster County Correctional Facilities (LCF), Juvenile Detention Center, Community Mental Health Center (CMHC) and Cornhusker Place. The contract will be in the approximate amount of \$554,149 per year for food preparation and an additional \$40,434.70 per year for delivery to LCF and the Juvenile Detention Center. In addition, negotiated prices for ARAMARK to provide food services and delivery to CMHC are as follows: \$1.114 per meal and \$200.56 per week for delivery. Term of the agreement shall be September 1, 2002 through August 31, 2005 with one, three-year renewal option. (C-02-0454)
- D. Correction of clerical errors on a cooperative agreement with the State of Nebraska, Department of Health and Human Services for wraparound services to state wards who reside in Lancaster County. The corrections are as follows:
 - 1. Delete references to County responsibility for costs necessary to implement and maintain the shared management information system.
 - 2. The County shall accept 70 youth instead of 77 youth by October 1, 2002 and the County will accept the remaining 121 not 114 youth by December 1, 2002.
 - 3. Total start up costs shall be \$323,460 paid to the County instead of \$223,460.

The agreement was approved September 3, 2002 under County contract C-02-0439. (C-02-0455)

- E. A resolution suspending the amount the County contributes each pay period to the Post Employment Health Plan (PEHP) for all unrepresented classified and unclassified employees. This is effective the pay period beginning August 22, 2002 and will remain in effect until further action by the County Board. (R-02-0102)
