A grant contract with Lincoln Medical Education Foundation (Family Violence Council) for the oversight and management of the "Coordinated Response to Reducing Domestic Violence" program (01-VW-716). The County shall make a grant in the amount of \$15,000 and the Lincoln Medical Education Foundation shall contribute \$3,900 in matching funds. - F. A purchase order/agreement with the United States Marshals Service for the provision of federal prisoner lunches at \$1.40 per meal not to exceed \$2,500 per year. The term of the agreement is October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003. (C-02-0524)
- G. A contract with Justice Benefits, Inc. for grant writing services and professional assistance to the Lancaster County Corrections Department in making application and claim for eligible funding under the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). The term of the agreement is a two year term from the date of execution for the following reporting periods: July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002 with application in January, 2003 and for July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003 with application in January, 2004. The County shall pay Justice Benefits, Inc. 22 percent of all revenue received by the County for SCAAP compensation. This agreement also acts as a recission of the County Board's approval and execution of County contract C-02-0400 which was the previous agreement with Justice Benefits. (C-02-0525)
