5) **OLD BUSINESS**:

A. An agreement with the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for modification and installation of the records management system at the Juvenile Detention Center to increase access to detention and release data for victim notification. The State shall pay the County \$3,600 for the modification to the County system. (C-03-0050)

- B. A memorandum of understanding with the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for access to information kept by the Crime Commission. The agreement provides security requirements that must be followed by the Juvenile Detention Center and staff designated with access to the database. (C-03-0056)
- C. First amendment to a lease agreement between General Electric Capital Corporation, County of Lancaster and Plastic Companies Enterprises, Inc. which amends the original lease agreement, dated October 1, 2002, for additional items of equipment which shall include one pre-fill automatic assembly machine, one pre-fill barrel tool and one pre-fill plunger tool and any other equipment acceptable to lessor which shall replace one robot and one 250 ton injection molding machine or one EDM tooling machine. The lease agreements were originally executed pursuant to Industrial Development Revenue Bond Plastic Companies Enterprises, Inc. Project, Series 2002, in the principal amount of \$1,300,000. - D. Contract with Midwest Fence Company, d/b/a Guardrail Systems Inc. for Bridge Rail and Guardrail Construction on County Project No. 03-03 for County Structure X-129. The construction is generally located in the area of South 54th Street and Panama Road. The County shall pay \$20,500 for the construction. Work shall be commenced by February 24, 2003 and be completed by May 16, 2003. (C-03-0058)
- E. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and the County Engineer to award a bid from a State of Nebraska contract (#CA-5417 REN (2)) to Murphy Tractor Equipment Company, for one tractor-loader including options as outlined in the recommendation, in the amount of \$60,433. (B-03-0007)
