All other terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect. (C-03-0174)
- L. An amendment to an agreement with the Indian Center. The original agreement was executed by the County on September 24, 2002 under County Contract C-02-0484 for providing care coordination using the wraparound process for youth. The amendment changes the ending date from July 30, 2003 to June 30, 2003 and changes the compensation from \$32,500 to \$29,250. All other terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect. (C-03-0175)
- M. An amendment to an agreement with Lincoln Public Schools. The original agreement was executed by the County on September 24, 2002 under County Contract C-02-0487 for providing care coordination using the wraparound process for youth. The amendment changes the ending date from July 30, 2003 to June 30, 2003 and changes the compensation from \$266,000 to \$243,833. All other terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect. (C-03-0176)
