The City is responsible for the cost of paving and construction of the project and responsible for maintenance on the new section of South 91st Street. The County shall give the City permission to perform the work and shall be responsible for maintenance on what is described as the Cheney Connection. (C-03-0304)

 - % \$35 per dose of Hepatitis B vaccine for each employee.
 - % \$10 per tuberculosis test for each employee.
 - % \$20 employment assessment for each employee.
 - % \$40 per hour for on-site lab services by a lab technician.
 - % Should the County Attorney's Office require conferences, meetings, or in-court testimony of nurses, it shall be billed to the County at the rate of \$42.50 per hour.
 - % Should the County Attorney's Office require conferences, meetings or in-court testimony of physicians, it shall be billed to the County at the rate of \$78.60 per hour.
