5) OLD BUSINESS:

A. A claim service and funding agreement with Specialty Risk Services, Inc. for claims services provided to the County. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2002 to October 1, 2003. The County will pay \$696 for each Bodily Injury claim, \$550 for each Property Damage claim under General Liability and \$1,626 for each Bodily Injury claim and \$41,191 for each Property Damage claim under Professional Liability. The County currently has an outstanding balance of \$4,322 which includes an annual administration fee of \$2,000. (C-03-0475)

- A. Request from the Nebraska State Board of Agriculture d/b/a Nebraska State Fair, located at 1800 State Fair Park, to delete an area known as Fair Café from their Class C (Retail) liquor license.

The City of Lincoln, United Way of Lincoln and Lancaster County will each pay \$35,000 of the total contract cost of \$105,000. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. (C-03-0588)
