A. An agreement with Amanda Andrae to assist with the monitoring and management of program evaluation for programs under the auspices of the Office of Juvenile Mental Health. Term of the agreement is April 1, 2004 through July 31, 2004. The County will pay up to \$28.84 per hour for such services. Total compensation under this agreement will not exceed \$20,000. - B. A utility relocation agreement relating to Project 04-13, Concrete Box Culverts, Lancaster County Structure D-26, Northwest 70th Street south of Raymond Road, between Lancaster County and Norris Public Power District of Beatrice, Nebraska. The total amount of the project is estimated at \$9,623.58 of which \$7,698.86 is estimated to be the share of the cost chargeable to the County. (C-04-0167)
- C. An interlocal agreement with Educational Service Unit 18 for educational services to youth detained at the Juvenile Detention Center, beginning August 16, 2004 and ending July 31, 2005. The County will reimburse ESU 18 up to \$837,780 for services provided. (C-04-0168)

- E. A consulting services agreement and statement of services with PeopleSoft USA, Inc. for the implementation of PeopleSoft as the financial system for Lancaster County. The approximate term of the agreement is April 13, 2004 through January 1, 2005. The County will pay approximately \$382,515 for such services. (C-04-0179)
- F. An agreement with Birttawni Lee Olson to assess and evaluate the Drug Free Communities Grant program, which operates within the limits and agreements made by Lancaster County and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention as part of the Lancaster County Human Services Department. Term of the agreement is April 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005. The County will pay \$10,750 for the services. (C-04-0180)
- G. An interlocal agreement with the Village of Hallam for one Sheriff's deputy to provide law enforcement services within the corporate limits of the Village of Hallam. Term of the agreement is May 1, 2004 through April 30, 2005. The County will be reimbursed at the overtime rate of pay for the deputy assigned to duty. The County will also be paid 37.5 cents per mile for the Sheriff's vehicle used in the provision of the services. (C-04-0181)
