- E. Supplemental agreement number 1 with the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads for Project BR-5204(2), Pioneers Boulevard. The County previously entered into a program agreement with the State regarding this project on August 10, 1999. The supplemental agreement sets the funding allocation for the project as follows: Federal-Aid Bridge Replacement Funds at 80 percent; State-Aid Bridge Funds at five percent; and County Funds at 15 percent. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement will apply. (C-04-0586)
- F. A service agreement with Stericycle for collection, removal and disposal of biomedical waste generated by Lancaster Manor. The agreement is effective December 1, 2004 for a three year term and includes a 60 day termination provision. The County will pay \$425 per month for the services. (C-04-0587)
- G. A contract for professional services with the Board of Regents, University of Nebraska, University of Nebraska Public Policy Center for the implementation of the Human Services Needs Assessment and Comprehensive Plan. The County will pay up to \$47,500 for the services. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2004 through December 30, 2004. (C-04-0588)
- H. A grant contract with United Methodist Ministries of Lincoln (Equity in Nebraska) for funding for the community-driven initiatives to address violence against women among diverse and traditionally under served populations while strengthening legal advocacy services for victims of domestic violence and dating violence, including assistance to such victims in immigration matters, in the amount of \$38,623. Term of grant contract is September 1, 2004 through August 30, 2005. (C-04-0589)
- I. A contract with Justice Benefits, Inc. for grant writing services and professional assistance to the Lancaster County Corrections Department in making application and claim for eligible funding under the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). Term of the agreement is December 1, 2004 to November 30, 2008, and includes a 60 day termination provision. The County will pay Justice Benefits, Inc. 15 percent of all revenue paid to the County for SCAAP compensation. (C-04-0590)
