NEW BUSINESS ITEM 6A:

Appointment of Ed Woeppel to the Lancaster County Board of Zoning Appeals to complete the unexpired term of Stan Matzke, ending March 31, 2008.

Ed Woeppel appeared and gave a brief overview of his experience.

MOTION: Workman moved and Heier seconded approval of the appointment of Ed Woeppel to the Lancaster County Board of Zoning Appeals to complete the unexpired term of Stan Matzke, ending March 31, 2008. Schorr, Heier, Workman and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried.

4) PUBLIC HEARINGS:

A. Continuation of a public hearing regarding an application for Corporate Manager for Orville A. Gertsch in connection with an application for a Class Y (Farm Winery) liquor license for Prime Country Winery L.L.C., located at 11800 Southwest 142nd Street, Denton, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (See New Business Item 6B for resolution.)

Hudkins reconvened the public hearing and asked if anyone wished to testify.

No one appeared and the hearing was closed.

B. An application for an amusement license from Fosters Tap Inc., located at 24049 South 12th Street, Princeton, Lancaster County, Nebraska to hold a street dance on Saturday, May 22, 2004 from 8 p.m. to 1 a.m..

Hudkins opened the public hearing and asked if anyone wished to testify.

Joleen Killham, applicant, appeared.

The Clerk administered the oath to Dan Killham, applicant.

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4) PUBLIC HEARINGS CONTINUED:

Mrs. Killham gave a brief overview of the following documentation which was submitted into the record (Exhibit 1):

Hudkins asked if two off-duty deputies had been hired.

Jarrett informed the County Board that no deputies had signed up for the event, noting that it is often difficult to get deputies to sign up for a non-community sponsored event due to safety issues.

In response to a question asked by Hudkins regarding alternatives, Jarrett suggested hiring private security.

General discussion followed regarding the hiring of off-duty sheriffs, parking monitor(s) and trash removal.

In response to a question asked by Jarrett regarding staff drinking during the event, the Killhams responded that no staff/security would be allowed to drink.

Hudkins asked if anyone else wished to testify.

No one appeared and the hearing was closed.

B. A resolution in the matter of County Change of Zone 04020, requested by Kenneth Morrow, from AG Agricultural to AGR Agricultural Residential on property generally located at Northwest 105th Street and West Fletcher Avenue in Lancaster County, Nebraska. (R-04-0042)

MOTION: Workman moved and Heier seconded approval of Resolution 04-0042 denying County Change of Zone 04020, requested by Kenneth Morrow, from AG Agricultural to AGR Agricultural Residential on property generally located at Northwest 105th Street and West Fletcher Avenue in Lancaster County, Nebraska. Heier, Workman, Hudkins and Schorr voted aye. Motion carried.

B. A resolution in the matter an application for Corporate Manager for Orville A. Gertsch in connection with an application for a Class Y (Farm Winery) liquor license for Prime Country Winery L.L.C., located at 11800 Southwest 142nd Street, Denton, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (R-04-0047)

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MOTION: Heier moved and Workman seconded approval of Resolution 04-0047 in the matter an application for Corporate Manager for Orville A. Gertsch in connection with an application for a Class Y (Farm Winery) liquor license for Prime Country Winery L.L.C., located at 11800 Southwest 142nd Street, Denton, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Hudkins, Workman, Heier and Schorr voted aye. Motion carried.

C. An agreement, in the amount of \$303,800, with Murphy Tractor and Equipment Company Inc. for two motor graders complete with trade-in allowance and mounting of V-snow plows for the County Engineer. Murphy Tractor will pay all costs of parts and labor in excess of \$4,800 per unit during the next seven years and the guaranteed repurchase of \$80,000 per motor grader after seven years. (C-04-0218)

MOTION: Heier moved and Schorr seconded approval of an agreement, in the amount of \$303,800, with Murphy Tractor and Equipment Company Inc. for two motor graders complete with trade-in allowance and mounting of V-snow plows for the County Engineer. D. An agreement with BryanLGH Medical Center to exchange parking bays with the County at the hospital facility located at 1600 South 48th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Term of the agreement will be from May 17, 2004 through and including July 31, 2005. (C-04-0219)

Kristy Mundt, Deputy County Attorney, referred to paragraph seven on page two of the agreement noting a change had been made. She stated the original agreement indicated there would be a pedestrian crossing across/around parking bay "B", however, that is no longer feasible due to construction in the area. Mundt read the amended language into the record: "BryanLGH will maintain adequate and safe ingress and egress to the Community Mental Health Center. Such safety improvements shall be agreed upon by the County before construction commences."

MOTION: Heier moved and Schorr seconded approval of an agreement with BryanLGH Medical Center with the changes as recommended by the County Attorney's Office. Workman, Schorr, Hudkins and Heier voted aye. Motion carried.

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E. An amendment to an agreement with the law firm of Orton, Thomas & O'Connell under County Contract C-02-0563 for legal representation to indigent parties in proceedings in the Juvenile Court of Lancaster County. The contractor has changed the name of her law firm and as a result the parties wish to amend the agreement to reflect such change. (C-04-0220)
