- F. An agreement with Maria J. Pendleton to coordinate the financial aspects of the completion and closing out of the SAMHSA Grant (Families First and Foremost) and prepare the comprehensive finance report as required by SAMHSA. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2005 through November 30, 2005. The County will pay \$12,000 for said services. (C-05-0368)
- G. An agreement with L.A. Young, Inc. for professional services of a nurse practitioner to assist in the provision of psychiatric services at the Community Mental Health Center. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006. The County will pay \$55 per hour for no more than 18 hours per week. (C-05-0369)
- H. An agreement with Cedars Youth Services for tracker services for adolescents placed in the Lancaster County Juvenile Drug Court. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006. The County will pay up to \$27,000 for the services. (C-05-0370)
