- G. An agreement with BryanLGH Medical Center for nursing services at the Crisis Center of the Lancaster County Mental Health Center. The nurses will be available 24 hours a day, seven days per week. Term of the agreement is from June 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. The County will pay \$47.16 per hour for the services. (C-05-0393)
- H. An interlocal agreement with the City of Lincoln, on behalf of Lincoln Electric System (LES), for reconstruction of Rokeby Road from a point 500 feet east of South 98<sup>th</sup> Street to a point 1,100 feet east of South 98<sup>th</sup> Street. The City will be responsible for the cost of reconstruction and the County will be responsible for all maintenance on the new section of Rokeby Road.
