An agreement with the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska and the Lincoln Housing Authority for the establishment and operation of the Nutrition Education Program (NEP) in order to address the nutritional needs of certain limited income persons living in urban housing in Lancaster County. Term of the agreement is September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2006. The County will pay \$16,966 for the services, which will be provided by the University. The Housing Authority will also pay \$10,519 for the services, combined with \$21,715 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Stamp Nutrition Education grant for a total of \$49,200. - H. An amendment to an agreement with UNICO Group, Inc. to extend the agreement for three additional one year periods, beginning September 1, 2005 and ending August 31, 2008. Total compensation for the first renewal year will be \$27,295 and no more than a three percent increase for the subsequent years. The original agreement is for the provision of insurance brokerage services for Lancaster County Property and Casualty. (C-05-0433)
- I. An amendment to a grant contract with Lincoln Council on Alcoholism and Drugs, Inc. (LCAD), under County Contract C-05-0140, to provide for the project management of the Federal Drug Free Communities Grant. The duties of LCAD have been amended to include a Screening and Brief Intervention (SBI) Program and a follow-up survey. As a result, the parties wish to amend the amount of the grant contract from \$62,505 to \$69,005. (C-05-0436)
- J. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and the Lancaster County Sheriff to award an order from a State of Nebraska contract (Contract #CA-6097A) to Husker Auto Group, in the amount of \$22,388.
