County Special Permit No. 05038, requested by Lyle Loth of ESP on behalf of Richard and Connie Roush and Gary and Darcie Kvasnicka, to construct dwellings within 1,320 feet of a public lake on property generally located northeast of the corner of South 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Wagon Train Road in Lancaster County, Nebraska.
- C. County Special Permit No. 05039, Wagon Train Estates Community Unit Plan requested by Lyle Loth of ESP on behalf of Richard and Connie Roush and Gary and Darcie Kvasnicka, to develop six residential acreage units with associated waiver requests on property generally located northeast of the corner of South 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Wagon Train Road in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

County Preliminary Plat No. 05013, Wagon Train Estates, requested by Lyle Loth of ESP on behalf of Richard and Connie Roush and Gary and Darcie Kvasnicka, to develop six residential acreage lots on property generally located northeast of the corner of South 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Wagon Train Road in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

# 4) **NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. A resolution authorizing the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners to apply for a Economic Development Block Grant, for the development of a Tractor Supply Company retail distribution center. (R-05-0132)
- B. A resolution authorizing the installation of traffic signs at the following locations: On Roca Road west of South 54th Street, install a "reduced speed ahead" sign 500 feet in advance of the existing 35 mile per hour speed limit sign located at the east village limit of Roca for westbound traffic; and relocate the 45 mile per hour speed limit sign for eastbound traffic to just east of South 54th Street. (R-05-0134)
- C. A grant contract with the Rape/Spouse Abuse Crisis Center for funding for the oversight and management of two full-time advocates who supply enhanced 24-hour advocacy to victims in person or by phone, in the amount of \$56,601, and advocate cell phone support, in the amount of \$1,200. Total amount of the grant contract is \$57,801. The grantee will contribute \$14,450 in matching funds. Term of the grant contract is from July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. (C-05-515)
- D. A grant contract with Lighthouse, Inc. for the management of Project HIRE, a job training and employment placement program for youth ages 16 through 18, in the amount of \$34,711. Term of the grant contract is September 1, 2005 through August 30, 2006. (C-05-0516)
- E. An agreement with the Child Guidance Center for the services of an internal case manager and for the provision of substance abuse evaluations for youth at the Youth Services Center. Term of the agreement is from July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. The County will pay up to \$58,952.67 for the services of the case manager and up to \$102,946.31 for substance abuse evaluations, for a total compensation amount of \$161,898.98. (C-05-0517)

# 4) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- F. An agreement between Peoples' Health Center (PHC) and Lancaster County in which PHC will provide unreimbursed medical, dental and behavioral health services to clients eligible for, but not receiving Lancaster County General Assistance in exchange for various equipment purchased by the County. Title to such equipment will be conveyed to PHC once PHC has provided the County with services, in the amount of approximately \$50,000. The agreement commences on October 18, 2005. (C-05-0518)
- G. A grant contract with CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) for Lancaster County to provide a Volunteer Coordinator to recruit minority volunteers to assist its high minority clientele, in the amount of \$13,022. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005. (C-05-0519)
- H. A grant contract with the Lincoln Medical Education Partnership (LMEP) (Family Violence Council) for the management of the Coordinated Response to Reducing Domestic Violence Program, in the amount of \$14,923 and the Spanish Language Coordinator, in the amount of \$6,760. The total amount of the grant contract is \$21,683 and LMEP will contribute \$4,950 in matching funds. Term of the grant contract is from July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. (C-05-0520)
- I. A grant contract with Madonna Rehabilitation Hospital for funding of the Community Medical Transportation Project, in the amount of \$12,500. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006. (C-05-0521)
- J. An amendment to an interlocal agreement with the State of Nebraska Probation Administration, under County Contract C-05-0347, for the management of the Lancaster County Juvenile Drug Court through the provision of a Drug Court Coordinator, Drug Court Officer and electronic monitoring services. The Department has hired a new Coordinator and Drug Court Officer, and as a result, the total compensation will be decreased from \$119,052 to \$106,110. (C-05-0522)
- K. Allowance Modification No. 07 to a contract with Progressive Construction Company for the Lancaster County vehicle storage facility, authorizing \$4,320.66 for connection of the new water service to the water line located in the County Engineer's building. (C-05-0523)

- L. Change Order No. 02 with Progressive Construction Company for the general construction contract for the Lancaster County vehicle storage facility, crediting the unused balance in the contingency allowance to Lancaster County. (C-05-0524)
