Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. (C-05-0589)
- I. An interlocal agreement with the City of Lincoln and United Way of Lincoln to jointly provide funding for the oversight and administration of the Community Services Initiative (CSI) Project. The City of Lincoln, United Way of Lincoln and Lancaster County, and the County will each pay \$40,000 of the total contract cost of \$120,000. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. (C-05-0590)
- J. An agreement between the State Court Administrator's Office and Lancaster County for reimbursement for 37 computers utilized by County employees in the District Court to access and operate Judicial Users System to Improve Court Efficiency (JUSTICE). The State Court Administrator's Office will reimburse the County at a rate of \$24 per computer, per month. The agreement is effective January 1, 2005. (C-05-0591)
- K. A catering agreement with the Cornhusker, A Marriott Hotel, to rent a room on January 23, 2006 to host a presentation on the Lancaster County Mental Health Jail Diversion Project. The County will pay \$525 for the room rental. Such cost will be paid from the Mental Health Jail Diversion Grant. (C-05-0596)
