Supplemental Agreement No. 1 between the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads for funding of the Lincoln South Beltway for the preliminary engineering, utilities, right-of-way construction, and construction engineering at Nebraska Highway 2 between 127<sup>th</sup> Street and U.S. Highway 77. The City, County and State previously entered into an agreement executed by the City on April 30, 2002, by the County on April 23, 2002 and by the State on May 9, 2002 that provided for the design and construction of the new Lincoln South Beltway. The supplemental agreement sets the funding allocation for the project as follows: project costs not covered by earmarked funds and associated match will be split 20 percent City and 80 percent State. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement will apply. (C-05-0602)
- J. A network provider contract with the Regional Behavioral Health Authority (Region V) for the provision of certain mental health, alcoholism, substance and related behavioral mental health services at the Community Mental Health Center.
