The meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:30 a.m..

1) MINUTES: Approval of the minutes of the Board of Commissioners meeting held on Tuesday, August 29, 2006.

2) **SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS**:

A. Announcement of receipt of the Bureau of Justice Affairs Mental Health Collaboration Grant for \$200,000 over a two year period. This grant funds the County's Jail Diversion Program.

Travis Parker, Mental Health Program Manager, introduced Kimberly Mundil, Mental Health Clinician, and Deb VanLent, Intensive Case Manager, who work with the jail diversion program and gave a brief overview of the grant award.
