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5) **NEW BUSINESS**:

- A. A contract with The Tool House Inc. for hand and power tools and related hardware items for Lancaster County agencies as recommended by the Purchasing Agent and Engineering Technologies. Prices are based on a discount to County agencies on an as needed basis. Term of the contract is February 15, 2007 through February 14, 2008 with an option to renew for up to two additional one-year terms. (C-07-0055)
- B. An agreement between Lancaster County and the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis authorizing the Reserve Bank to initiate debit entries and credit adjustments for any debit entries processed in error, pursuant to the applicable Rules of the National Automated Clearing House Association and the Upper Midwest Automated Clearing House Association, for transactions involving payments for the sale of United States Savings Bonds purchased through payroll deduction plans. - C. An agreement with Platte County Ambulance Co. to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Platte County Ambulance Co. will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30 day termination provision. (C-07-0057)
- D. Utility Permit No. 842 with the City of Lincoln for utility construction on County property 2,110 feet east of South 1st Street across Old Cheney Road. There will be no cost to the County. (C-07-0058)
- E. A resolution in the matter of County Special Permit No. 06059, requested by U.S. Cellular Wireless Communications for authority to construct a 199 foot tower for wireless facilities located approximately one-quarter mile north of the intersection of North 176th and "O" Streets, Lancaster County, Nebraska. The resolution includes a collocation agreement for emergency communications equipment (see Site Specific Condition No. 2) and replaces Resolution No. 06-0127 previously approved by the County on December 5, 2006.
