- A. Applications for Special Events Permit from Nebraska Sports Council to hold the following events:
 - 1. <u>Link Urban Adventure Race</u> on Sunday, April 1, 2007 beginning at 9:00 a.m.. The race will be held within the city limits of Lincoln with the exception of a portion which will be from South 84th and Van Dorn Streets to South 112th and Van Dorn Streets, turning north on South 112th Street to the MoPac Trail.
 - 2. The Lancaster County Sheriff's Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge 29 Adventure Race on Saturday, April 21, 2007 beginning at 8 a.m.. **NOTE:** A majority of the race will be held at Wagon Train Lake. The race will begin at South 110th Street and Hickman Road, proceeding east to South 120th Street where it will turn south and proceed to Wagon Train Road. The route will then turn west onto Wagon Train Road and proceed to South 110th Street turning south to Hedgefield Lake and return by proceeding north on South 110th Street to Wagon Train Lake.

4) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- B. A grant contract with Lincoln Council on Alcoholism and Drugs, Inc. to provide funding for the project management of the Federal Drug Free Communities Grant, in the amount of \$72,950. The Grantee will contribute \$122,537 in matching funds which may include cash or in-kind services. Term of the grant contract is October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007. (C-07-0062)
- C. An interlocal agreement with Cass County for the safekeeping, care and sustenance of juveniles while at the Youth Services Center. Lancaster County will be reimbursed \$244.50 per youth, per day. The agreement is effective upon execution and has a 30-day termination provision. (C-07-0063)
- D. An addendum to an agreement with Great Plains Appraisal, Inc., under County Contract No. C-03-0596, for services of qualified professional appraisers to assist the Lancaster County Assessor's Office in performing the appraisal functions necessary to process the Tax Equalization and Review Commission (TERC) appeals for the 2003 tax year. The addendum authorizes Great Plains Appraisal to also process the TERC appeals for the 2006 tax year. (C-07-0064)
- E. A program agreement between the Lancaster County Engineering Department and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads for replacement of County Bridge No. T-108; Project No. BR-3280(4), Sprague East. The County's share of the project cost is estimated to be \$110,200. (C-07-0065)
- F. An interlocal agreement with the City of Lincoln for the widening and reconstruction of Folsom Street, more particularly described as South Folsom Street from West Denton Road to a point 1,439 feet south of West Old Cheney Road. There will be no cost to Lancaster County and the City will be responsible for maintenance of the new section. The agreement is effective upon execution until completion which is estimated to be the fall of 2007. (C-07-0066)
- G. A contract with Buller Fixture Company for a Hobart conveyor dishwasher, in the amount of \$21,746, for the Lancaster County Corrections Department. (The County Board awarded the bid on January 30, 2007.) (C-07-0067)
- H. Release of a personal guarantee of Ron and Linda Meyer on the Project Financing agreement of RRJ, L.L.C. d/b/a Legacy Dairy and Creamery, under County Contract No. C-06-0121. (C-07-0068)
- I. An agreement between the City of Lincoln, on behalf of the Urban Development Department and Lancaster County for professional services and administration of the Lancaster County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Loan Program. The agreement will commence upon execution of both parties and continue through August 31, 2007. The County will pay up to \$12,000 for such services. (C-07-0069)

 - c. Delete the provision that a preliminary plat shall be effective for only ten years and authorize the Planning Director to determine if a new preliminary plat may be required after five years rather than the County Board.
 - d. Reword procedures regarding filing the Planning Commission's findings within seven days with the County Clerk.
 - e. Change public hearing notice dates when signs are posted and notices appear in the newspaper to be consistent with the City's notification requirements.
