An agreement with Lincoln Endoscopy to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Lincoln Endoscopy will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30 day termination provision. (C-07-0096)
- C. An interlocal agreement between Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln for the paving of Yankee Hill Road from South 40th Street to South 56th Street in a modified Rural to Urban Roadway Transition Streets Program (RUTS) design. The County will contribute \$300,000 for the project and the City will be responsible for all project costs over \$300,000, up to a maximum of \$200,000. (C-07-0097)
