### 4) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- C. Agreements with Professional Anesthesia Services and Lincare to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreements set forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care, and Professional Anesthesia Services and Lincare will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreements are effective upon execution of all parties and contain a 30 day termination provision. (C-07-0137 and C-07-0145)
- D. A contract between the Lancaster County Engineering Department and Brandt Excavating, Inc., in the amount of \$167,625.63, for erosion control at various box culverts and bridges located within the County. The work will be performed between May 14th and September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2007. (C-07-0138)
- E. An amendment to a grant contract between Lancaster County and Lincoln Medical Education Partnership, under County Contract No. C-06-0518, for funding for the Family Violence Council and the Pathways to Self-Sufficiency Through Education program. Funding is no longer required for the Pathways to Self-Sufficiency Through Education program, and the parties wish to reduce the total amount of the contract from \$56,383 to \$33,508. (C-07-0139)
- F. Utility Permit 849 for the City of Lincoln Wastewater System for the installation of water service from the intersection of Folsom Avenue and West Pioneers Boulevard south two miles to West Denton Road at no cost to the County. Utility Permit 849 replaces and supercedes Utility Permit 841 which is found at County Contract No. C-07-0029. (C-07-0140)
- G. An agreement between the City of Lincoln d/b/a the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Community Mental Health Center. The Community Mental Health Center will provide a smoking cessation program for 10 individuals and will be paid \$6,000 by the Health Department. (C-07-0143)

- H. Renewal of a maintenance agreement with Environmental Systems Research Institute Inc. (ESRI), for the ArcInfo software used by the Lancaster County Engineer and County Assessor/Register of Deeds Geographic Information System (GIS) system, in the amount of \$15,600. The agreement covers technical support, software upgrades and user conference registrations requested by the County Engineer and County Assessor/Register of Deeds for their GIS system. Term of the agreement is July 21, 2007 through July 20, 2008. (C-07-0144)
- I. An agreement between Lancaster County and Great Plains Appraisal, Inc. for appraisal services. The County will pay Great Plains \$3,500 to perform an appraisal of Lancaster Manor, to be completed no later than August 1, 2007. (C-07-0146)
- J. A mini-grant application and award through the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety for the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office to participate in the 'Click It or Ticket' campaign promoting zero tolerance for safety belt and child restraint violations beginning April 22, 2007 and continuing through June 22, 2007. Approximate amount of the grant award is \$7,726.
- K. Appointment of Ron Fetters as the Interim Administrator for Lancaster Manor, beginning May 3, 2007 for a period of up to six months.
- L. A request from Margaret Pierson for a refund of real property taxes.
