A. Partial release of an easement between Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln d/b/a Lincoln Electric System, Windstream Nebraska Inc., Time-Warner Entertainment - Advance/Newhouse releasing the west ten feet of the south 150.02 feet of Outlot A, Finigan View 1st Addition and the south 15 feet of the west 65.50 feet of Outlot A, Finigan View 1st Addition, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (C-07-0301)

# 6) **NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. A resolution in the matter of County Special Permit No. 07024, requested by Gregory and Heidi Rettele, for authority to locate and occupy a mobile home while building a permanent residence on property generally located at Southwest 14th Street and West Olive Creek Road, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (R-07-0071)
- B. A resolution authorizing the installation of traffic signs in Lancaster County as follows: Install Signal Ahead signs (W3-3) at the following locations: westbound on Van Dorn Street on the approach to South 84<sup>th</sup> Street, northbound on South 40<sup>th</sup> Street on the approach to Yankee Hill Road, westbound on Yankee Hill Road on the approach to South 40<sup>th</sup> Street; Install Bicycle Warning signs (W11-1) at the following locations: Martell Road, west of South 38<sup>th</sup> Street for eastbound and westbound traffic, South 25<sup>th</sup> Street, south of the Hickman Road for northbound and southbound traffic, Stagecoach Road, east of Highway 77 for eastbound and westbound traffic, South 12<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Highway 77 for northbound and southbound traffic, and Firth Road, east of Highway 77 for eastbound and westbound traffic; and install a pavement ends sign (W8-3) on West Bluff Road 500 feet from the end of the new pavement for eastbound traffic. - C. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Crime Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for the Building Our Assets Together (BOAT) grant. The County will receive \$103,066, of which \$78,066 is the County's match share. Term of the grant award is July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. (C-07-0310)
- D. A real estate purchase agreement between Lancaster County and West O Properties L.L.C. for the purchase of 37.41 acres of real estate legally described as Lots 73 and 74 located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.. The cost to the County is \$2,250,750. (C-07-0311)

## 6) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- E. An agreement with the Child Guidance Center for the services of an internal case manager and for the provision of substance abuse evaluations for youth at the Youth Services Center. Term of the agreement is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. The County will pay \$63,614.84 for the services of the case manager and \$108,391.99 for substance abuse evaluations, for a total compensation amount of up to \$172,005.85. (C-07-00312)
- F. An interlocal agreement between Lancaster County and the Administrative Office of the Courts, an agency of the State of Nebraska, for the administration of the Adult Drug Court for the District Court of Lancaster County through the provision of one Drug Court Coordinator, two Drug Treatment Court Caseworkers and one Clerk. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The Administrative Office of the Courts will pay the County \$172,039 for the services. (C-07-0313)
- G. An agreement with Cedars Youth Services for tracker services for adolescents placed in the Lancaster County Juvenile Drug Court. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The County will pay up to \$28,000 for the services. (C-07-0314)
- H. An agreement with Segal Advisors for pension consultation services for the Lancaster County Employees Pension Program. The agreement is effective upon execution by both parties and will continue for a period of one year. The agreement may be renewed for an additional one year period for Phases 3 and 4 upon mutual written agreement of the parties. The County will pay Segal Advisors as follows: Phase I, Initial Pension Plan Review: \$8,000; Phase 2, Review of Investment Plan: \$6,000; Phase 3, Assistance in Bidding: \$50,000 and Phase 4, As-Needed Investment Advice \$300 per hour. (C-07-0315)
- Agreements with See The Trainer-Lincoln and Cardiology Group, L.L.C. d/b/a BryanLGH Heart Institute to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreements set forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and See The Trainer-Lincoln and Cardiology Group, L.L.C. d/b/a BryanLGH Heart Institute will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreements are effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30 day termination provision. (C-07-0316 and C-07-0317)

## 6) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- J. A lease agreement between Lancaster County and Healthy Families Project for approximately 502.5 square feet of office space in Trabert Hall, located at 2202 South 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. Healthy Families Project will pay the County \$397.82 per month for the leased space. (C-07-0318)
- K. An agreement between the Lancaster County Engineering Department and Lincoln Electric System for Project No. HRRR-55(161), Walton, Nebraska to add roadway lighting at the intersection of South 120<sup>th</sup> and "A" Streets for safety purposes. The construction will occur in September/October of 2007 and the estimated cost to the County will be \$6,024. (C-07-0319)
- L. An amendment to an agreement with Pierson Fitchett Law Firm, under County Contract No. C-05-0371, for legal representation to indigent parties in the Separate Juvenile Court of Lancaster County. The Contractor will accept additional juvenile cases for the period August 15, 2007, through September 11, 2007, due to an immediate staffing shortage at the Public Defender's Office. The County shall pay \$7,020 for such services. The Contractor also agrees to accept up to 25 new law violation cases. The County shall pay Contractor \$360.00 for each new law violation case. (C-07-0324)
- M. Approval of a software license agreement with MDI Technologies for an Accounts Receivable module for the use of Lancaster Manor. Lancaster County shall pay \$13,918.50 for the license fee and a nonrefundable license fee deposit of \$4,639.50 upon execution and delivery of this agreement. A HIPAA Business Associate agreement is included. (C-07-0325)
- N. Approval of a software license agreement with MDI Technologies for Clinical Care Solutions for the use of Lancaster Manor. Lancaster County shall pay \$14,600.70 for the license fee and a nonrefundable license fee deposit of \$4,866.90 upon execution and delivery of this agreement. A HIPAA Business Associate agreement is included. (C-07-0326)
- O. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and Lancaster Manor to award a bid to ABC Siding, in the amount of \$47,444.60, and to Pyramid Roofing, in the amount of \$123,993, for roof replacement at Lancaster Manor. Total award will be \$171,437.60. (B-07-0043)
- P. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and Records and Information Management to award a bid for annual requirements for microfilm supplies to Spectramedia, Inc., AMS Imaging, Inc. and Anacomp, Inc.. The products will be ordered on an as needed basis. (B-07-0044)
